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GRANT APPLICATION TIPS

Grant applications are a competitive process, and it is important to set your organisation up for success ahead of time, to have the best chance of securing the funds you need. Below are some tips and tricks to help with applying for grants.

1. Be prepared

Have all your grant information and organisation information prepared and ready to go ahead of time. Put together a package of information about the organisation which you can use to apply for grants and get your applications completed in a timely manner. Don't wait until the last minute to pull this information together.

2. Applications and decisions take time

Grant funding cannot be relied upon for last-minute financial needs. Most grant processes are not designed to accommodate urgencies, and instead, should be viewed through the lens of longer-term relationships. Many grant deadlines occur annually, or in rounds of funding and the assessment and decision-making process can take anywhere from one to six months or longer for large federal grants.

3. Ensure you submit all requested documentation

Grant applications will usually require supporting documentation and will specify exactly what documents you need to submit. Ensure you submit everything that is requested or your application may be automatically declined as non-compliant.

4. Provide compelling evidence

When you are putting the grant application together, make sure you include compelling evidence as to why you need the funds and how they will benefit your organisation and the community you serve.

5. Measuring and reporting your outcomes

Funders have clear expectations. Projects should be mission-aligned and should demonstrate a tangible purpose. Funders are interested in understanding the impact of their contributions. Organisations must be able to measure the outcomes of their projects (either quantitatively or qualitatively) and report this back to their funders.

6. Funds can only be used for the specific funding purposes.

Grant funding can only be used for the purpose for which it was awarded and in line with the conditions of the grant. Ensure your funding request specifies exactly what you intend to use it for and use it for that purpose only. Do not use grant funding for other purposes other than the specified purpose. If you have unspent funds, some funders may allow you to apply to use them for other purposes, on request for approval by the grant funders.

7. Building relationships and trust.

Relationships with your donors is critical for long-term grants success. To access longer term, unrestricted, multi-year funding, funders must trust an organisation to

deliver projects aligned to their stated mission. This means communication is key. Clear communication ensures that potential donors understand the purpose, goals, and intended outcomes of projects, allowing them to make informed decisions. Regular updates and transparency on how funds are utilised also provides accountability, reassuring donors that their contributions are making a meaningful difference.

8. Grant writing

Writing grants and putting a submission together is a key skill to have in your organisation, particularly when applying for large federal or state government grants. Consider employing the services of a grant writer to assist in preparing these types of submissions or have your grant writers attend grant training.

9. Attend Briefing sessions

When briefing sessions are offered or mandated in the grant, ensure you attend these to gain the maximum insight into the grant process and key information.

10. Finally, some questions to ask of your organisation.

- Is there an agreed process for internal project planning and development?
- Is monitoring and evaluation built into projects?
- Is there a centralised, prioritised 'wishlist' of pipeline projects?
- Is there a 'Key Messages' document, containing key organisational information that donors and funders typically require to assess organisation's capabilities?
- Is there an efficient, regular and systematic approach to finding the right funding and grant opportunities for each of your projects?
- Does the organisation have the writing experience and skills internally to prepare strong donor and funding submissions?
- Do submissions succinctly provide strong evidence, rate highly and leave no unanswered questions for funders?
- Are donor and funder reports delivered for funding received and are they on time?
- Is time spent building relationships with funders prior to applying for grants and funding?

does this by creating the resources, insights and community for women to shortcut their success. And while they believe you can do a lot on hustle, sometimes girls just need funds. So SPARK are reinvesting their profits back into quarterly grants.
